Please use this Development Fund Proposal Form to guide your proposal.

- Final proposals will be reviewed by the Systems of Care Grant Team and approved by the Systems of Care Youth and Family Subcommittee.
- The final proposals will then be approved by the Systems of Care Governance Board at its April 2016 meeting.
- Approved proposals will be used to develop contracts with deliverables and pay points to be completed within one year of award with NAMI Indiana, who will administer the funds.

Please note the following:

- Based on the values of the Indiana Systems of Care Strategic Plan, only proposals will be funded that:
  - Show statewide or regional impact.
  - Include youth and families in leadership, planning, or governance roles.
  - Focus on collaboration across systems, e.g. criminal justice, education, primary health care, faith communities, etc.
- The strongest proposals in the first round were budgeted between \$7,500 and \$15,000.
- Proposals should be focused on time-limited projects that can be sustained locally, rather than on ongoing staff positions to maintain a local systems of care governance board or existing program.
- Proposal previously submitted and not funded should be re-submitted and revised using the guidance above.
